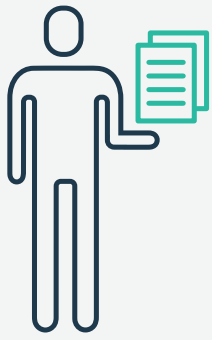
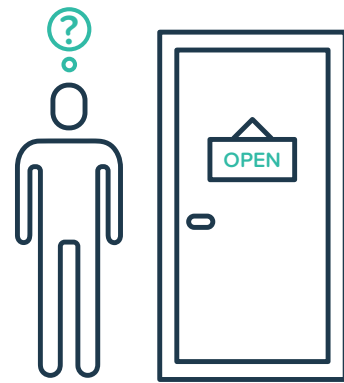


Preparing Your Business for Reopening

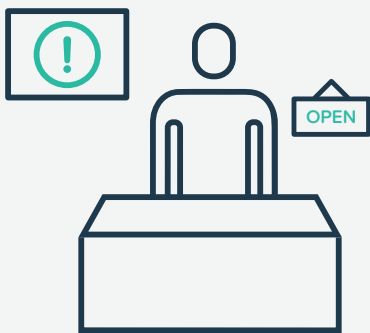
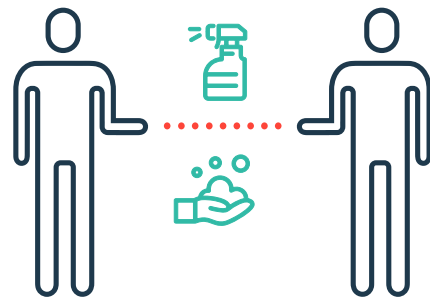


2 Review and implement GNB official measures

- Measures are outlined in the [Guidance Document](#) of General Public Health Measures During COVID-19 Recovery.
- Operators should have pre-screening tools, plans for physical distancing, and cleaning and disinfection procedures.

3 Develop an operational plan

- Your operational plan does not require GNB approval but we ask that you keep it on file in case you are called upon to present it.
- WorkSafeNB has developed a guide and plan [template](#).
- Inspections are not required prior to reopening.



4 Display COVID-19 awareness information in your workspaces / public spaces

- Signage must be posted on [proper hand hygiene](#), cough etiquette, and physical distancing throughout the facility and outdoor settings as applicable.
