

NB Small Business Recovery Grants



Information you'll need on hand to apply:

1. Business Start Date

- i. The date your business commenced operations.

2. CRA Business Number

- i. Your 9-digit federal business number for payment remittances. This number will be included on your PD7A and other correspondence from Canada Revenue Agency.

3. Your 9-digit federal social insurance number (SIN) (if your business is a sole proprietorship)

- i. If your business is a partnership, you will need the SIN for all of the partners.

4. Electronic / scanned copies of relevant income statements (note that each month could be a separate document to be uploaded or could be combined into one document for uploading).

- i. Amount of sales for your business in month(s) when your business was subject to public health alert orange or red level. Only the months of October 2020 through March 2021 may be eligible.
- ii. Amount of sales for your business in the same month(s) one year ago, or February 2020 if your business commenced between October 1, 2019 and January 31, 2021 and did not have a full month of sales for any of those months.

5. Electronic / scanned copies of most recent PD7A – Statement of account for current source deductions.

6. Electronic Direct Deposit Form (optional)

- i. If your business is not already set up as a supplier to the Province of New Brunswick, please complete and attach the signed GNB Supplier Registration Direct Deposit Form which can be found [here](#).
- ii. The alternative option will be a cheque issued to your business.
